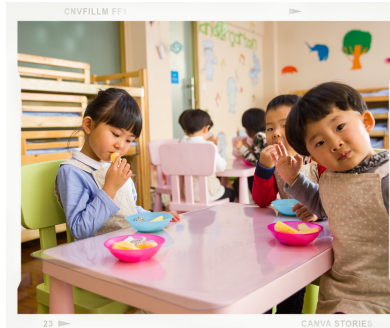
Head Start
